

**The Scottish Wedding Show, SECC, Glasgow  
8 -9 October 2016**

**Are there ID requirements or an age limit to enter the event?**

Children under 16 are admitted to the show free of charge, but if booking in advance, a zero value ticket should be booked. If a child will be occupying a seat in the Catwalk Fashion Show, a ticket will be required for that child at a cost of £2. VIP tickets are for patrons over the age of 16 years, however in exceptional circumstances, patrons under that age may be admitted - please contact the Organiser direct to discuss.

**What are the show dates?**

Saturday 8th & Sunday 9th October 2016. If you can't make it to this show, our spring show dates are Saturday 25th & Sunday 26th February 2017.

**What are the show opening times?**

Saturday 8th October 2016 -10am-5pm  
Sunday 9th October 2016 - 10am-5pm

**Will all exhibitors be at the show both days?**

Yes, exhibitors are contracted to be at the show from doors opening at 10am on Saturday 8th October until the show closes at 5pm on Sunday 9th October 2016.

**What are the times of the Catwalk Fashion Show?**

There will be 3 performances each day at 11.00am, 12.30pm and 2.30pm. Tickets must be purchased for Catwalk Fashion Shows, and must be supported with an Entry only ticket.

**Do I have to bring my ticket to the event?**

Yes, you should print your ticket or have it visible on your mobile/tablet, as all tickets booked in advance will be scanned on entry.

**Can my Entry ticket be used on any day?**

Your entry ticket is valid for one day only and can be used on either the Saturday or Sunday.

**Can my Catwalk ticket be used on any day/performance?**

Your Catwalk ticket can only be used on the day/performance booked and must be supported with an Entry only ticket.

### **The name on the registration/ticket doesn't match the attendee - is that ok?**

Yes, that's ok as the person registering can use their name on all tickets booked, in the event they don't have other members of the party details. Each ticket has a separate barcode, so just ensure you have all tickets printed/visible on mobile/tablet for scanning on entry to the show.

### **What is the best way to get to the venue?**

Situated just off Junction 19 of the M8 motorway, the SECC is within five minutes drive of the city centre and 15 minutes from Glasgow International Airport. Visit our dedicated travel page for detailed information on getting here.

### **What are parking options at the event?**

Parking is available at the large multi-storey car park located at the front of the SECC building. There are 1600 spaces within the car park and the address is 10 Stobcross Road, Glasgow, G3 8YW. The multi-storey car park has a height restriction of 1.9m.

### **How much does parking cost?**

### **Is there an ATM/Cash Machine at the venue?**

Yes, Clydesdale Bank ATM facilities are available on the SECC complex.

### **Does the venue offer disabled access?**

Yes, the SECC is fully accessible. The SECC main building has automatic doors at both East and West entrances and the exhibition hall is situated on ground level.

### **Are wheelchairs available for hire?**

The Medical Centre has a limited number of wheelchairs that visitors may 'borrow' for the duration of their visit. Wheelchairs are allocated on a first come, first served basis and can be booked the day before your visit. ### **Are disabled/accessible toilets available?**

The SECC has disabled and accessible toilets situated on the main concourse and in all exhibition/event halls. Radar keys for accessing disabled toilets are available from a member of staff or to purchase from the Information & Business Centre on the main concourse.
